### DAY 1 SINGAPORE X XI'AN

#### ( MEALS ON BOARD )

### DAY 2 **XI'AN**

#### (LUNCH)

- Xi'an City Wall Walk along the ancient Xi'an City Wall, the largest and most intact city wall in China. The wall, built during the Ming Dynasty, is 12 meters high and runs over 13 kilometers around the city.
- Yongxingfang Food Street -Located near the Xi'an City Wall, this famous street showcases traditional Shaanxi food, including specialties that are part of China's intangible cultural heritage. Enjoy a wide array of street foods and local snacks.

#### DAY 3 **XI'AN**

### (BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER)


• Daxie Lane Mosque - The oldest mosque in China, blending traditional Chinese architecture with Islamic elements. This 1,300-year-old mosque houses a monument commemorating Zheng He's voyages to the West.


- Xi'an Museum + Little Wild Goose Pagoda - Learn about Xi'an's ancient history at the Xi'an Museum, which features exhibitions on topics such as Buddhist art, ancient calligraphy, jade, and more. The museum is located within the Jianfu Temple complex, home to the Little Wild Goose Pagoda. Enjoy a performance of ancient music as part of the experience.
- Datang City That Never Sleeps -Visit vibrant cultural and entertainment district inspired by the grandeur of the Tang Dynasty. Visit the squares dedicated to Tang figures like Xuanzang, and enjoy cultural venues such as the Xi'an Concert Hall, Shaanxi Grand Theater, and Xi'an Art Museum. This bustling pedestrian street is a hub of shopping and entertainment.

#### DAY 4 XI'AN - LINTONG - XI'AN

#### (BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER)


**Museum of Terracotta Warriors** and Horses - One of the greatest archaeological discoveries in history. Take a electric car to explore the three burial pits that house over 8,000 life-sized terracotta soldiers, horses, and chariots. Known as the "eighth wonder of the world."

 Shuyuanmen Four Treasures of the Study Street - Explore this historic street, known for its well-preserved Ming and Qing architecture. It once housed the prestigious Guanzhong Academy and now offers shops specializing in traditional cultural items like calligraphy supplies.

- Sajingqiao Food Street Enjoy the authentic flavors of Hui cuisine as you stroll through alleys lined with food vendors showcasing the vibrant street food culture of Xi'an.
- Xingqing Park Built on the site
  of the Tang Dynasty's Xingqing
  Palace, this scenic park is a
  peaceful retreat, known for its lush
  landscapes and historical
  importance, especially during the
  spring season.
- Northwest Business Center A modern business hub in Xi'an that combines shopping, dining, and entertainment, offering products ranging from fashion to jewelry.

# DAY 6 XI'AN

#### (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

- Grand Mosque of Xi'an (Additional Tour) - The largest and best-preserved famous Islamic mosque in China, with traditional architectural forms and layout.
- Huimin Street (Additional Tour)
  - A cultural and commercial center for Hui and Muslim communities featuring a bustling array of markets, food vendors, and Islamic-style buildings.
- Bell and Drum Tower Square (Additional Tour) - Visit the striking Bell Tower, the largest and best-preserved of its kind in China, made of wood and standing on a brick and stone base.
- Legend of Camel Bell
  (Additional Tour) Enjoy a reallife singing and dancing
  performance centered on the
  "Belt and Road" theme. This show
  highlights the cultural legacy of
  the Silk Road during the Tang
  Dynasty.
