- Formosan Aboriginal Culture Village (Lunch Own Expenses) -Experience Taiwan's indigenous heritage at this cultural and amusement park. Explore traditional tribal houses, witness vibrant dance performances, and enjoy thrilling rides, all set against the scenic backdrop of Sun Moon Lake.


- Gaomei Wetland over 300 hectares divided into 7 categories, results in diversified organisms in this area. Gaomei Wetlands is one of the few places that have wild ducks. Despite the small area, Gaomei Wetlands have unique soils mixed with mud and sand. Ecology here breeds diversified organisms of both plants and animals. Research shows that animals here include birds, fishes, crabs and invertebrates.
- Fengjia Night Market Taiwan's largest night market offers a vibrant mix of local street food, trendy shops, and fun games. Don't miss must-try treats like bubble tea, stinky tofu, and grilled squid.

DAY 4

- Old Mountain Line Railbike -Offers a scenic ride along a historic railway track, allowing visitors to pedal through lush landscapes and picturesque views.
- Schokolake Chocolate DIY A delightful destination for chocolate lovers of all ages. This charming country house offers visitors the opportunity to create their own personalized chocolate treats in a fun and interactive setting.
- Seasonal Fruits **Picking** Experiences - Get up close and personal with Taiwan's seasonal bounty by harvesting fresh, ripe fruits directly from the trees or vines. Experience the joy of picking fruit at its peak of freshness.
- Flying Cow Ranch Offers a fun, family-friendly experience with farm activities, animal interactions, and outdoor adventures. Visitors can enjoy milking cows, feeding animals, and exploring the scenic countryside.







DAY 5 MIAOLI – TAIPEI (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)


- Pineapple Cake DIY At a local pastry workshop, master the art of making Taiwan's famous pineapple cakes. Take home your handmade treats as souvenirs.
- CKS Memorial Hall Is a grand monument dedicated to the former President Chiang Kai-shek. The impressive structure features a large, iconic dome and is surrounded by expansive gardens, serving as a major cultural and historical landmark.
- Taipei Underground Shopping
 Street A vast network of
 underground malls offering a mix of
 fashion, electronics, souvenirs, and
 local snacks. Perfect for bargain
 shopping, exploring anime and K pop merchandise, or escaping the
 heat and rain while enjoying Taipei's
 retail scene.

DAY 6 TAIPEI

(BREAKFAST, DINNER)

• Taipei 101 Observatory – Located on the 89th floor, offers stunning 360degree views of Taipei and beyond. Visitors can reach it via a high-speed elevator, and it features indoor and outdoor viewing areas. It's especially beautiful at night with the city lights. A must-see in Taipei!

- Taipei Grand Mosque the most gigantic and oldest mosque in Taiwan. Built in 1960 with funds donated from Taiwan and Saudi Arabia. The main distinguishing feature of the mosque is its enormous domed roof. The dome is 15 meters high, 15 meters in diameter and is supported entirely without beams.
- Ximending known as the Harajuku of Taipei or Shibuya of Taipei, is the source of Taiwanese fashion, subculture, and Japanese culture. Everyone can find what they need right here in Ximen Shopping District!





 Free time at your own leisure until time to depart for the airport for your flight home.


